$$I = (\mu V \text{ output})/S \pm \text{sqrt}(2)*U95\%$$

Where: I = the irradiance measured by the pyranometer $(\mu V \text{ output})$ = microvolt output of the pyranometer S = calibration coefficient of the pyranometer U95% = the 95 % confidence level
